

- 6. member of the Senate chosen to be the presiding officer in the absence of the President of the Senate
- 8. sets groundrules for debate in the House of Representatives
- 10. to distribute seats as in a legislative body
- 11. assign to a particular use
- 13. to redistribute the seats of a legislative body
- 14. provision added unto a bill
- 15. sole power of the House of Representatives to formally charge an elected official
- 16. a measure expressing an opinion; does not have the force of law and does not require the President's signature
- 17. current officeholder
- 18. review of the Executive Branch by the Legislative Branch

- 2. to reject
