C#18- Necessary and Proper Clause-Elastic Clause

EXECUTIVE- PRESIDENT

Art. 2, Sec. 2

Power to make treaties

Power to veto legislation

Commander in Chief

Power to Appoint

JUDICIARY- SUPREME COURT

Art. 3- No expressed powers

Creates a Supreme Court

Establishes Jurisdiction
